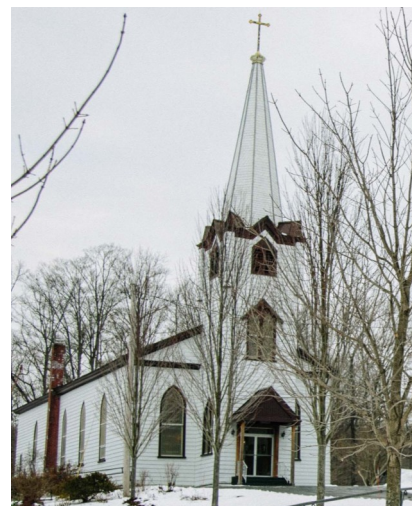

Pastor's Desk



Dear Friends in Christ,

1. Within the Liturgy of Mass, several changes over the years have helped us to conform to liturgical practices. Most recently, the bishop has decreed that following the Agnus Dei, we are called to kneel or sit and NOT remain standing. The bishop's decree puts us in common posturing with other dioceses surrounding Erie,

2. Every once in a while, the image of Jesus' coming in honor, glory, the power of God himself is presented in a way that diminishes the greatest power of nature and this worldly strength is presented. There is no comparison! The power of this world is presented as being very weak compared to the power of Jesus. Our posture within the Eucharist reverently give us kneeling or sitting with others as we await the next action of the liturgy following communion.

We pray in the name of Jesus and we will receive and it shall be given to us. The Lord is the source and summit of victorious power. It is beyond everything that we can imagine in worldly power. Let us rest in the peace of Jesus' promises!

3. Mark down the Thanksgiving Service for Albion churches of Tuesday, November 23, 7:00 pm at St. Lawrence Church. This is an Ecumenical Service presented by several local pastors and ministers. We ought to have good participation by members of this parish!

Being Thankful

As we approach Thanksgiving, hopefully, you can pause and reflect on God's blessings from the past year. I am sure that for some years it is harder than others to see any blessings. If it is challenging, maybe start with one or two things that we take for granted; a beautiful sunrise on a crisp Fall morning that starts by just lighting the tops of the trees, a walk around the block with the dog, or a cup of hot coffee or tea in the morning with a scone or warm cinnamon roll. I recently saw a dad using a leaf blower on his front lawn, and his toddler son, who was about two years old, was jumping in the air with excitement. The fact that such a simple and ordinary thing like a leaf blower could create such exuberance and joy made me smile.

There are five types of Catholic prayer:

- Praise and Worship
- Petition and Intercession
- Supplication
- Spiritual Warfare
- Thanksgiving

I have found that if prayer is a challenge, I try to start with one or two blessings I am thankful for. Here is a simple prayer of thanksgiving from Beth McLendon that may help:

As I express my gratitude to you in prayer, may it be a pleasing, joyful sound to you.

Thank you, Lord, for your love. It brings me acceptance and significance.

Thank you, Lord, for your truth. It brings me guidance and direction.

Thank you, Lord, for your mercy. It brings me help and comfort.

Thank you, Lord, for your faithfulness. It brings me stability and strength.

Thank you, Lord, for your beauty displayed in the earth. It brings me joy and delight.

Thank you, Lord, for your way of redemption - the cross. It brings me salvation and regeneration.

Try to take some time this week to reflect on one or two things you are thankful for.
