

#### WHOSE SON ARE YOU, ANYWAY?

In rhetorical speech, which includes preaching and teaching, three elements are important: the *mythos*, or the message; the *logos*, or the words used; and the *ethos*, or the qualifications of the speaker. The message may be clear, the words may be elegant and persuasive, but if the speaker is not seen as someone who is qualified to speak on the subject, the speech will not be convincing.

In today's Gospel, the people are questioning Jesus' credentials. "Is this not Jesus, the son of Joseph?" (John 6:42). "He's a local boy, where did he get this knowledge?" Jesus answers them with his teaching about God as true Father. If you know who your teacher is, you know what your message should be. Jesus' important words about the Eucharist are grounded in his self-knowledge as "the one who is from God" (John 6:46). Those who are from God know God and listen to the word of God. They will recognize Jesus as speaking, doing, and being that Word. The ethos of the hearer is on the line as well.

#### **TAUGHT BY GOD**

The people who know God as "Father," that is, intimately and in deep and loving relationship, will recognize Jesus as the One who reveals God to us, even if the message is challenging. For any speech to be understood and accepted, there has to be an audience, and that audience has to hear, understand, and be able to accept what is being said. Jesus makes the point that if we know God, as he does, we will see and understand that, just as God fed the people in the desert, God feeds us and sustains us with the Bread of Life, the Eucharist, which is Christ the Lord. He is not only the speaker, but the word and the message as well. This Bread is the gift of a loving and faithful God who gave us life and sustains it.

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Friends in Christ:

The <u>Sunset Sail</u> on the <u>Lettie G Howard</u> is coming soon. If you have signed up, please drop your \$35 check off at the office. If you have not signed up but would like to sail with us on the 16<sup>th</sup>, contact the office MONDAY the 13<sup>th</sup> and I will see if there are any openings immediately. We

board from 6:00 to 6:30 and the ship takes off precisely at 6:30 pm for an enjoyable 2 hour cruise.

The day-long coach bus trip to <u>Seneca Casino</u> will leave our parking lot at 7:30 am on September 24. Your \$40 payment needs to accompany your reservation for space. There is a \$25 gaming card and \$5 luncheon card that will be given to you upon arrival at the casino. So your day's event, trip and entertainment will actually only 'cost' you \$10 if you only use the 'incentive' casino cards.

We are proceeding to develop a 'parish bingo' commitment. Currently, we are looking to have it on Monday or Thursday nights with doors opening about 6:00 for set up, 6:30 concessions open, 7:00 Early Bird Game followed by Regular and Special games, concluding with a 'Cover-All Jackpot' that should conclude at 10:00. We will design our game to include the highest payouts possible based on number of players and design of the games. Instant tickets, 50/50, and other rotating drawings will be available throughout the evening.

There are several volunteers who gathered to discuss the enterprise last week and some of us are attending various bingo games in our area to get a 'sense' of what people are used to, reflect enjoyment about and we intend to generate positive thoughts about what can make our bingo attractive and enjoyable for participants and workers alike and generate a steady operations income to benefit our parish and mission parish.

I have heard that a couple of pessimists voiced their concern about 'supporting gambling' as if it was morally questionable and a 'religious institution' ought not to do it! Are you serious?! Churches have been supported by bingo for generations, casino trips generate fun, community experiences, and funding for church support for decades! Truly, *excessive* gambling, squandering limited assets is harmful. Addictions are harmful in every sense, but we still have open or limited bars at wedding receptions and provide high calorie foods for community gatherings to enjoy. 'Excessive use' is not the same as normal use for enjoyment and social bonding.

Having community-building experiences and entertainment activities are positive, developmental projects to bring people together, enjoy company, share the excitement of 'chance' and have more to talk about. Some are *just fun*, like the Sunset Sail; others are fun and *generate parish funds* such as the casino trips and bingo. But *all are positive experiences* to enjoy with friends and family, and extended family – parish.

May Our Lord bless you and these adventures we are exploring...
