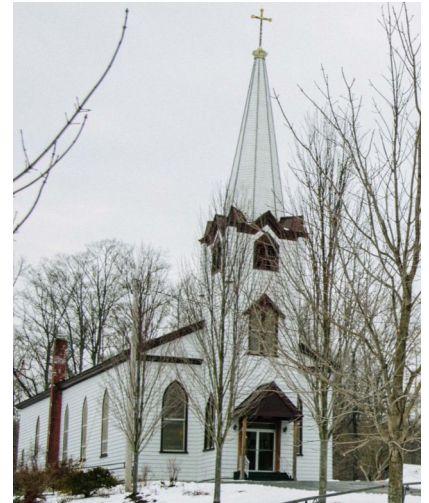

Fall is a reminder to us of nature's cycle of life. It also reminds me of the verse in Ecclesiastes 3:1, *"For everything, there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven."*
