Deacon's Corner

July 17, 2022

On our way to Myrtle Beach for vacation, we stopped overnight in High Point, NC. We were able to attend Mass at Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish. Thus, this is another example of the many opportunities we have had to attend Mass in various areas of the country, including Florida, North Carolina, South Carolina, Ohio, New York, West Virginia, Washington, DC, Arizona, Texas, and Montreal, Quebec.

Our recent trip reminded me of the universality of the Roman Catholic Church. When you attend Mass at another local church or a church in another state, you can count on the Mass having the same prayers, Mass parts, and Scripture readings. This has always provided me with a sense of peace and a feeling of familiarity to be a visitor to a parish. Also, it has helped me appreciate the richness of the Church. A few years back, while on business travel, I attended daily Mass at a Texas parish and was surprised to hear liturgical music from a choir of four men that did beautiful Gregorian chant. It was a very blessed and peaceful ending to a long workday.

The universality of the Church should be no surprise since the Nicene Creed declares the Church to be One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic.

The word Catholic comes from the Greek word *Katholou*, meaning "thought of the whole" or "universal." The *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, Paragraph 868 says: *The Church is catholic; she proclaims the fullness of the faith. She bears in herself and administers the totality of the means of salvation. She speaks to all men. She encompasses all time. She is a "missionary of her very nature."*

Of course, the most incredible comfort I receive at any Mass or parish is that all are welcome, both saint and sinner. Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners. So, be open to God's blessings as we attend Mass this week.
