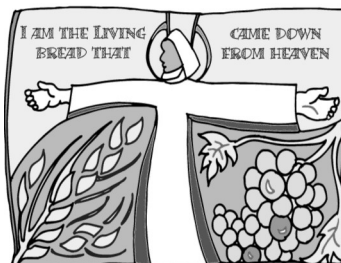

FLESH AND BLOOD

In Jesus' words to the crowds in today's Gospel we hear him talk about our participation in the Eucharist as a sharing in his own flesh and blood. Through the Eucharist Christ himself dwells in us. His divine and eternal life courses through our veins. Like a family gathered at table, we become more and more intimately connected with Christ and one another. As Paul tells us, "We, though many, are one body" (1 Corinthians 10:17), united as members of Christ's own flesh and blood.

FOR THE LIFE OF THE WORLD

Within the Body of Christ today, many are suffering as Jesus once did, and the suffering of one of our "brothers and sisters" should be of deep concern to us. We who partake of the Body and Blood of Christ must be prepared to be broken and poured out as Jesus was "for the life of the world" (John 6:51). We must become willing to suffer ourselves if it will benefit a member of our own "flesh and blood."

As you receive Holy Communion this week, open your heart to the intimate connections that unite us as family within the Body of Christ. Then reflect on how those bonds will affect the way you treat your own flesh and blood this week.

**From the
Pastor's Desk**


Dear Friends in Christ:

As we celebrate Corpus Christi, the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ, we are reminded of our Catholic Heritage, especially. The Roman and Byzantine Churches believe in the Real Presence of Christ most especially in the consecrated Bread and Wine at Holy Mass. We gather to adore Christ in Exposition, be blessed by Christ in Benediction, and receive Jesus in Holy Communion. The Real Presence of Christ in our Eucharist sets us apart from all other Christian denominations as being the One, True, and Apostolic Church. We take it literally that Jesus commanded us to 'take and eat...take and drink... this IS my body...this IS my blood!' Given up for us so that we can reconcile and be welcomed into the Heavenly Kingdom.

Some 'secularized Catholics' have drifted from allegiance and fail to frequent the celebration of the Eucharist. Some have disrespected the Eucharist by neglecting their spiritual practice. Some have oriented to 'entertainment services' rather than devotional prayer participation. These and so many others have not nourished their spiritual lives with the Real Presence of Christ in a long time. They are vulnerable to worldly, political, immediate gratification and have lost a sense of 'humbleness before the Lord.' If they pray, it is only for a 'magical intervention' rather than reinforcement of welcoming God's Will.

The divisiveness of our culture is a symbolic consequence of compromising the prime values and principles espoused in our Declaration of Independence and Constitution, or a prejudicial distortion of them that justifies even the opposite of what they truly mean. People can distort God's Word and attempt to justify their sinful attitudes and behaviors, too. These practices do not make wrong right!

We do need to 'get back to the basics.' We do need to 'bend the knee' before the Blessed Sacrament. We need to prayerfully read and reflect on the Gospel teachings of Jesus who calls us to holiness. We need to focus our prayerful gatherings to reconcile for sinful silence in the face of prejudice and dehumanization. We need to truly see Christ in each other and respond to His Presence in every person's soul and learn how to communicate with Christ lovingly. Corpus Christi, the Body of Christ IS real and present to us in so many ways! Let us have reverence, respect, and gratitude. And let us be distant or silent no longer!
