THE KINGDOM OF GOD IS LIKE . . .

Jesus speaks in several parables today about the reign of God, including images from several groups of people in order to make his message clear to all who hear. The kingdom of God is like a man who sows good seed. The kingdom of God is like a person who plants a mustard seed. The kingdom of God is like a woman who adds yeast to her flour. All of these very human activities bring home the fact that the reign of God is already among us, working in small ways to bring about mysterious but very great results.

Good and evil are allowed to grow together until the end, lest the good be destroyed with the evil. There is a lesson for us here. It is not that we shouldn't oppose evil when we see it, but that in our zeal to make our world perfect by human force, we must be careful not to destroy the work that God is doing. It is not for us, but for God to judge what is to be kept and what destroyed, and even though we think we know the difference, we must be cautious not to disturb God's carefully planted goodness in others. Violence can never be the means of justice.

Dear Friends in Christ:

Let *Patience* be a special characteristic in our personality readiness to deal positively with the mixed messages we are getting from so many levels of society these days. The internet is filled with people expressing rage, self-righteousness indignation, or platitudinous semi-serious 'rules to live by' poetically or graphically trying to shame people by exaggeration of fundamental moral principles. The evidence in either direction points to the lack of solid grounding in human relationship responsibility. Today's Reading from the Book of Wisdom teaches: ...the Lord judges with mercy and governs with care. God teaches people kindness, hope, and repentance.

During Pandemic, we have to realize how important it is to change in every aspect of our lives and that it will *never* go back to the way we were. Instead, we have to be patient, prepared for making science-based decisions, with kindness, hope and acceptance of our limitations. We can be helpful to each other and grateful for help we receive. Our American psychology is strongly ego-centric and that is a handicap when we have to commit to working with each other as community members.

The evolution of humanity at this point in history targets the dangers of disease and our unpreparedness to deal with it well, the effects of social cancers of racism, prejudice, and self-defeating lethargy to change for the better. Only with God's help can we overcome deeply rooted negative attitudes and practices... so let today's Gospel message of reliance on God's grace be a source of light and hope.


