

#### Rule 6: Make Friends

This week, let's continue to look at the book Living Joy: 9 Rules to Help You Rediscover and Live Joy Every Day by Chris Stefanick. Rule 6 is Make Friends.

Chris Stefanick quotes a Harvard study that says its not money, fame, success, or even health that allow people to thrive in old age. It's about friendship. "People with good, healthy relationships ended up being happy and healthy into old age."

"The soil where friendship grows is time, intimacy, and mercy." You can grow and develop your friendships in three ways:

- Put in hard time. Friendship takes time and effort. Digital connections are real, but they are not deep enough. There is great value in face-to-face interactions and setting aside time on your calendar to connect with your friends. Make time for a phone call, grab coffee, or do some shared activity.
- 2. <u>Be intimate</u>. Real friendships are intimate. Instead of just asking, "How are you doing today?" ask instead, "How are you really doing?" "What are you grateful for?" "What are you struggling with?" "What is God doing in your life?"
- 3. <u>Be merciful, and let things go easily.</u> "The only way to grow in friendship over time is to forgive easily." People we know can offend us, and don't even know what they did. You deserve that freedom of forgiving and the joy of friendship. In the Our Father, we say, "forgive us our trepasses as we forgive those who trespass against us." Life is too short. Don't waste any of it on holding grudges that can destroy relationships. Chris tells us, "People aren't easy. Get over it so that you can experience the blessing it is to have long-term, meaningful, supportive friendships with other people who are as imperfect as you are."

May you experience God's peace and joy as you spend time with your friends.
