

Why So Angry?

Every week I receive a newsletter by e-mail from Mark Joseph Ministries. Mark Joseph started and grew a very successful business in the Pittsburgh area. Then, he became very passionate about his faith and decided to leave the business world and work for the Catholic Church. He joined Franciscan University in Steubenville in 2012. Today, Mark is the Vice President of Outreach and Evangelization. In his role, he is part of a team that gets to evangelize, educate, and empower tens of thousands each year. In 2018, he also wrote the book *Overwhelming Pursuit: Stop Chasing Your Life and Live, which uses his life experiences in business and faith.*

A recent newsletter from the end of August asks why so many people are so angry. It does not matter what the subject is; we seem less tolerant than in the past. Typical politeness is much less prevalent. We have forgotten what many of us were taught, "if you don't have anything nice to say, then don't say anything at all." We are so eager to respond to online posts or the daily news without a filter and with little regard for our comment's negative impact.

In prayer, Mark Joseph discerned that his anger was from \underline{ego} and \underline{pride} . Ego really means \underline{E} dging \underline{G} od \underline{O} ut. We seem to want to get in the last word and feel obligated to share our own "correct" opinions.

Anger seems to fade when we remember to practice surrender, gratitude, humility, and love. Then, when you live in the place of God's unconditional love, you remember He made you with unique gifts. God put you on earth for a purpose, including wanting you to be happy and to spread his unconditional love.

If you are angry, pause and reflect on God's unconditional love and think are we practicing this same love?


