

Rule 8: Serve

This week, let's continue to look at the book Living Joy: 9 Rules to Help You Rediscover and Live Joy Every Day by Chris Stefanick, Rule 8: Serve.

Chris starts this chapter with, "To experience true joy, your heart has to shift from self-centered to other-centered. The only way to truly shine is to help others shine." Serving others should be part of the sacrifices of almsgiving we practice during this upcoming season of Lent.

"Your stuff makes you more comfortable but not happier. That's why wealthy people with the wrong hearts are so miserable. What sad irony." "Stop letting your heart believe the lie that happiness lies in more success, more notoriety, more stuff, or more zeros in your bank account. Stop digging for your treasure in the wrong place."

Serving others with time, talent, and treasures leads to joy. Pope Saint John Paul II writes, "We are not looking for a shallow joy but rather a joy that comes from faith, that grows through unselfish love... We realize that joy is demanding; it demands unselfishness." Chris further tells us, "Taking on the mind of a servant doesn't only make you holier; it makes you happier."

Here are three simple tips on how to develop a heart and mind to embrace service:

- 1. <u>Claim it. Out loud</u>. You need to preach to yourself, "I want to serve others today. Help me find opportunities to serve."
- 2. <u>Don't just sit there. Do something.</u> Serve the poor by each month giving time or money to an organization that serves the poor. Remember that little acts of service are a big deal. "We underestimate our impact because we weigh things with the wrong scales.
- 3. <u>Give money away.</u> "It's a scientifically proven fact that money can, in fact, make you happy, but only when you spend it on other people!" Winston Churchill once said, "We make a living by what we get. We make a life by what we give." By giving, we can be an answer to someone's prayer.

During this Lent, pray for some ways you are being called to serve.

NOTICE – LENTEN PRACTICES 2024

The season of Lent begins this year on Ash Wednesday, February 14, 2024, and concludes when the Paschal Triduum of the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of the Lord begins at the start of the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, March 28, 2024.

The following practices and regulations are promulgated and binding for all Latin Rite Catholics in the Diocese of Erie for Lent and the Paschal Triduum, 2024. Eastern Rite Catholics who may be attending Latin Rite parishes have their own proper regulations and should consult their own eparchy or parish.

- Traditional Lenten practices of PRAYER, FASTING, and ALSMGIVING, and other forms
 of self-denial, are recommended most warmly by the Church. Daily Mass is particularly
 encouraged.
- 2. **ASH WEDNESDAY, ALL FRIDAYS IN LENT,** and **GOOD FRIDAY** are days of **abstinence** from eating meat for those 14 years of age and older.
- 3. In 2024, St. Patrick's Day (March 17 Principal Patronal Feast Day of the Diocese of Erie) falls on the Fifth Sunday of Lent. In recognition of the importance of this day for the faithful, Bishop Persico has directed that St. Patrick be liturgically observed (at daily Mass, Divine Office, etc.) throughout the diocese on Monday, March 18, 2024.
- 4. ASH WEDNESDAY AND GOOD FRIDAY are also days of <u>fasting</u> for those ages 18 to 58 inclusive. (On these days, those bound by the law of fasting may take one full meal. Two smaller meals, sufficient to maintain strength according to one's needs, are also permitted. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids including milk and fruit juices are allowed. When health or work is seriously affected, the law does not oblige.)
- 5. On **HOLY THURSDAY**, no celebration of the Mass is to begin anywhere in the diocese earlier than 4:30 pm without the explicit approval of Bishop Persico.
- 6. Although it does not include the Liturgy of the Eucharist, by its very nature the GOOD FRIDAY service is celebrated by a priest only.
- 7. All celebrations of the **EASTER VIGIL** are to begin *after nightfall* (which is defined as approximately one hour after local sunset.) Nightfall is about 8:45 pm this year. To balance pastoral need and liturgical prescriptions, Bishop Persico has decreed that the Easter Vigil in the Diocese of Erie is to begin at 8:30 pm or any later time. Any start time earlier than 8:30 pm must receive explicit approval from the Bishop.
