

Deacon's Corner

The Luminous Mysteries of the Rosary

Since October is the month of the Holy Rosary and the Church celebrates the feast day of Pope Saint John Paul II on Oct. 22nd, it seems appropriate to look at John Paul II's contribution to the rosary. His contribution is the addition of the five Luminous Mysteries.

Pope Saint John Paul II had an enormous devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary and the Most Holy Rosary. In 2002 the pope added the Luminous Mysteries to the rosary, and in his apostolic letter, "Rosarium Virginis Mariae," explained the appropriateness of these "mysteries of light."

"Moving on from the infancy and the hidden life in Nazareth to the public life of Jesus, our contemplation brings us to those mysteries which may be called in a special way "mysteries of light". Certainly the whole mystery of Christ is a mystery of light. He is the "light of the world" (Jn 8:12). Yet this truth emerges in a special way during the years of his public life, when he proclaims the Gospel of the Kingdom. In proposing to the Christian community five significant moments – "luminous" mysteries – during this phase of Christ's life, I think that the following can be fittingly singled out: (1) his Baptism in the Jordan, (2) his self-manifestation at the wedding of Cana, (3) his proclamation of the Kingdom of God, with his call to conversion, (4) his Transfiguration, and finally, (5) his institution of the Eucharist, as the sacramental expression of the Paschal Mystery."

In addition, John Paul II pointed this out in his apostolic letter—none of the other Mysteries of the Rosary involve Christ's ministry itself. The Joyful Mysteries cover Christ's conception to his twelfth year; the Sorrowful Mysteries cover Christ's Passion; the Glorious Mysteries cover events subsequent to Christ's death. Only in the Luminous Mysteries are we invited to meditate upon Christ's earthly ministry.

Pope Saint John Paul II pray for us that we may increase our devotion to the Holy Rosary.
