

# **Celebrating the Easter Season**

A recent article from the Catholic New Agency titled *Lent is over*. Now what? The article opens with a question, "Chocolate bunnies and marshmallow Peeps have graced the shelves of U.S. stores for weeks in anticipation of Easter, but now that the actual Easter season has begun, how should Catholics observe it?

The Easter Triduum follows the 40-day penitential season of Lent, marked by penance, prayer, and almsgiving. We shouldn't feel like we must abandon good Lenten practices during Easter if those practices help us to be better Catholics, especially if we gave up things that were occasions of sin."

Father Chrysostom Baer of the Norbertines of St. Michael's Abbey in Orange County, California, provides his insights:

"I would think the first best way to celebrate the season is to go to daily Mass. That is bar none the best," Baer said. "Because it really puts you in the mind of the Church, with regard to the season. The prayers change every day, but they're all focused on the Resurrection."

"Catholics should also continue any good practices they fostered during Lent such as prayer or almsgiving, he insisted, and should give attention to virtues they cultivated from Lenten penance."

"The Easter season is for fostering those virtues that you've planted during Lent and allowing them to grow," he said. This requires taking "concrete steps" and not just vague promises to ensure that good habits are maintained, he added."

However, Easter shouldn't just be lived at church; it's got to live out in our everyday lives. There must be a more intense realization that every aspect of our life has come into communion with God.

The feasts of the Easter season are best share with family and friends. All God's Blessing this Easter season as we remember that Christ died and rose from the dead for each and every one of us.
