TEMPTED BY TRANSFIGURATION

Jesus faces a different sort of temptation in today's Gospel. Peter (whom Jesus would refer to as "Satan" in their encounter at Caesarea Philippi) tempts him to stay on the mountain of the Transfiguration, residing in a tent of glory with Moses and Elijah, as the Ark of the Covenant had dwelt in a tent of glory among the people of Israel. Jesus doesn't succumb, but makes Peter and his other followers come down with him off their mountain of glory to continue their ministry of proclaiming the reign of God. Jesus turned down the glory and power offered to him in last week's temptation passage; he likewise turns it down again, even when it seems to portray him as the fulfillment of Israel's messianic expectations. Yet, in a way, Jesus did allow himself to be tempted by transfiguring moments in his public ministry when he faced illness, demons, disbelief, hypocrites. He allowed each of these moments to transfigure the world around him more and more into the image of God's reign. They also each transfigured him a bit more on his road to Jerusalem, Calvary, the tomb, and his everlasting transfiguration in resurrection.

TRANSFIGURED BY TEMPTATION

The words "disciple" and "discipline" are very close relatives. People in various walks of life know that our personal transfigurations frequently happen only when we encounter times of trial. Those in recovery know that ongoing encounters with temptations are sources of growth and strength. And so it is for us as faithful disciples renewing our lives through Lenten disciplines. We need to turn aside from the allure of the temptations of self-centeredness, greed, and unhealthy appetites as we increase the presence of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving in our lives. Daily, most of us confront a "demon," an illness in body, mind, or spirit, whether in ourselves or in the world. With Christ, we are called upon to confront its presence in ourselves or others, and like Christ, find our true and lasting transfiguration by growing in obedience to the Father's will. By God's grace we will one day come to live in the everlasting glory of the Resurrection that we also share.

The transfiguration is such an unusual experience for the disciples! In the ordinariness of their gathering for prayer, Jesus appears different, there is a voice revealing Him as being the one especially loved by God the Father, and the disciples see how different Jesus is from them. They experience great fear of Jesus, His Presence with the Father, and cower in His Presence.

What would your response to the transfiguration be if you were there on that mountain? Moses was on the mountain when he encountered Yahweh! Moses brought them the tablets of Covenant, the Old Testament Constitution, which formed them into being God's People. Everything changed!

What changed for the disciples?

Things got a lot more formal. Jesus' teaching became more Gospel – Centered and personal. As they came down from the mountain, their relationship with Jesus changed – they looked at Him with awe and wonder. They were set apart from the other disciples and audience. They were changed. They saw what no one else saw, they heard what no one else heard. How did that affect what they heard Jesus saying in the next few months?

Pay attention to the transfiguration! It alone changed the hearts and lives of these men as never before!

Who were these special men? What did they experience in prayer with Jesus? How did their experience change the way Jesus looked, and sounded from that day forward?




