

# Deacon's Corner

June 12, 2022

#### **The Holy Trinity**

This weekend we celebrate the Most Holy Trinity. The Trinity is the central mystery of the Christian Faith yet such a challenge to explain. The doctrine of the Trinity is that there is One God existing as three equally divine "Persons," the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Our minds cannot quickly grasp this doctrine, which teaches that 1+1+1 equals 1 and not 3. The Church defined the dogma of the Trinity at the First Council of Nicaea in 325 A.D and the First Council of Constantinople in 381 A.D.

Unsurprisingly, there have been countless homilies, reflections, articles, and books written about the Trinity, each trying to explain the infinite. Here are two simple examples:

- St Patrick used a shamrock leaf that looked like one leaf but had three parts. He said the mystery of the Trinity is like this but more complex and incomprehensible.
- St Cyril tried to explain the Mystery of the Most Holy Trinity using the sun. "God the Father is the blazing sun, God the Son is its light, and God the Holy Spirit is its heat; but there is only one sun."

The terms Trinitarian or Holy Trinity are not used anywhere in Scripture, but there are many examples of God, as one God in the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. An article from Catholic Answers, "Defending the Trinity," describes just some of the Trinitarian Scripture references in the Gospel of John, Ephesians, Acts of the Apostles, Hebrews, and Corinthians.

We may never fully understand the Holy Trinity since we are finite, and it is infinite, but we can be sure it represents the creation of Love.
