Deacon's Corner August 21, 2022

The Queenship of the Blessed Virgin Mary

On August 22nd, the Church celebrates the Oueenship of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

Pope Pius XII established this feast day in 1954. However, Mary's Queenship has strong roots in Scripture and traditional prayers. We remember the Coronation of Mary in the last Glorious Mystery of the Rosary. Mary as "Queen of Heaven" is an ancient address given to Mary in prayer that dates back to at least the fourth century. Also, the imagery of Mary as queen of heaven was prevalent in the Middle Ages.

In Israel, the mother of the king held the role of the queen mother. In essence, she had a position of great prominence in the court, and the king would usually acquiesce to her wishes as described in 1 Kings 2:20; *Then she said, "I have one small request to make of you do not refuse me." And the king said to her, "Make you request, my mother, for I will not refuse you."*

As Jesus is the king, that makes Mary his queen mother according to Jewish tradition. Getting to the king through the queen mother spurred Christians to ask Mary to intercede to Jesus on their behalf. Mary's Queenship is a sharing in Jesus' Kingship.

The feast of the Queenship of the Blessed Virgin Mary is a logical follow-up to the Assumption and is celebrated on the octave day of that feast (the eighth day after a feast). In the Encyclical *To the Queen of Heaven*, Pope Pius XII points out that Mary deserves that title because she is the Mother of God and because of her intercessory power.

Rightfully, Mary was assumed into heaven and crowned queen of heaven and earth.

Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us.

Philip Benizi was born Italy on August 15, 1233. Philip possessed a deep love of Mary and the crucified Christ and was known for his kindness and concern for the poor, his unique humility and strong zeal for the work of the Kingdom of God.

He attracted many converts to the Church, and reconciled many others. He helped St. Juliana establish a Servite Third Order and he later retired to an impoverished Servite House at Todi, where he died on August 22, 1285. He was canonized on August 23, 1671.
