September 18, 2022

Fall

This week September 22nd is the official beginning of fall. We are already seeing and experiencing many of the signs of fall. The days are growing shorter with less and less daylight. The still warm and comfortable days lead to cooler nights. Also, the leaves are starting to turn colors. Among my favorite part is the return of apple cider season.
