## Palm Sunday of The Passion of the Lord



Palm Sunday is the day we celebrate the triumphal entry of Jesus into Jerusalem, one week before His resurrection .

As Jesus entered the holy city, He neared the culmination of a long journey toward Golgotha. He had come to save the lost, and now was the time—this was the place to secure that salvation.

Palm Sunday marked the start of what is often called “Passion Week,” the final seven days of Jesus’ earthly ministry.

Palm Sunday was the “beginning of the end” of Jesus’ work on earth.

Dear Friends in Christ:

This weekend we remember strangers welcoming Christ into Jerusalem – The High Holidays are pressing – strangers gather to welcome each other and to symbolically welcome the Word Made Flesh. Jesus was one of many – “Pretenders to the throne” who strived to initiate fidelity to one marginal group or another. Jesus’ proclamations went farther than others... He claimed himself to be God’s only Son. In the midst of the culture, that alone was singularly reprehensible! He had to die!

Yet, he was heralded! He was welcomed, even though it was a mockery—to some, it was valid, an acknowledgment of his divinity and the completion of the Old Testament’s Promise – In the Person of Jesus alone, all the promises of ancient Israel come to fulfillment. This motley crew was correct despite itself.

Jesus was welcomed into His City – His Temple – among His People. As you and I take a slip of palm today, let us imagine we are among that strange crew waiting at the city gates to welcome Christ, the Lord! Now, 2021 years later, do you personally welcome Christ in your lives? What form does that take? Is there evidence in your life that you are truly a believer?

This week we gather to celebrate Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Vigil. It is a time of resolution and promise. Resolution for the commitment Jesus made for you and for me, to have our sins forgiven. Promise that we will celebrate the fullness of eternal life in His Name.

Our celebration is all about Him, but it involves ourselves as well. We walk along with him; we witness His paying the final price of our Salvation! We receive eternal life as a divine gift!
