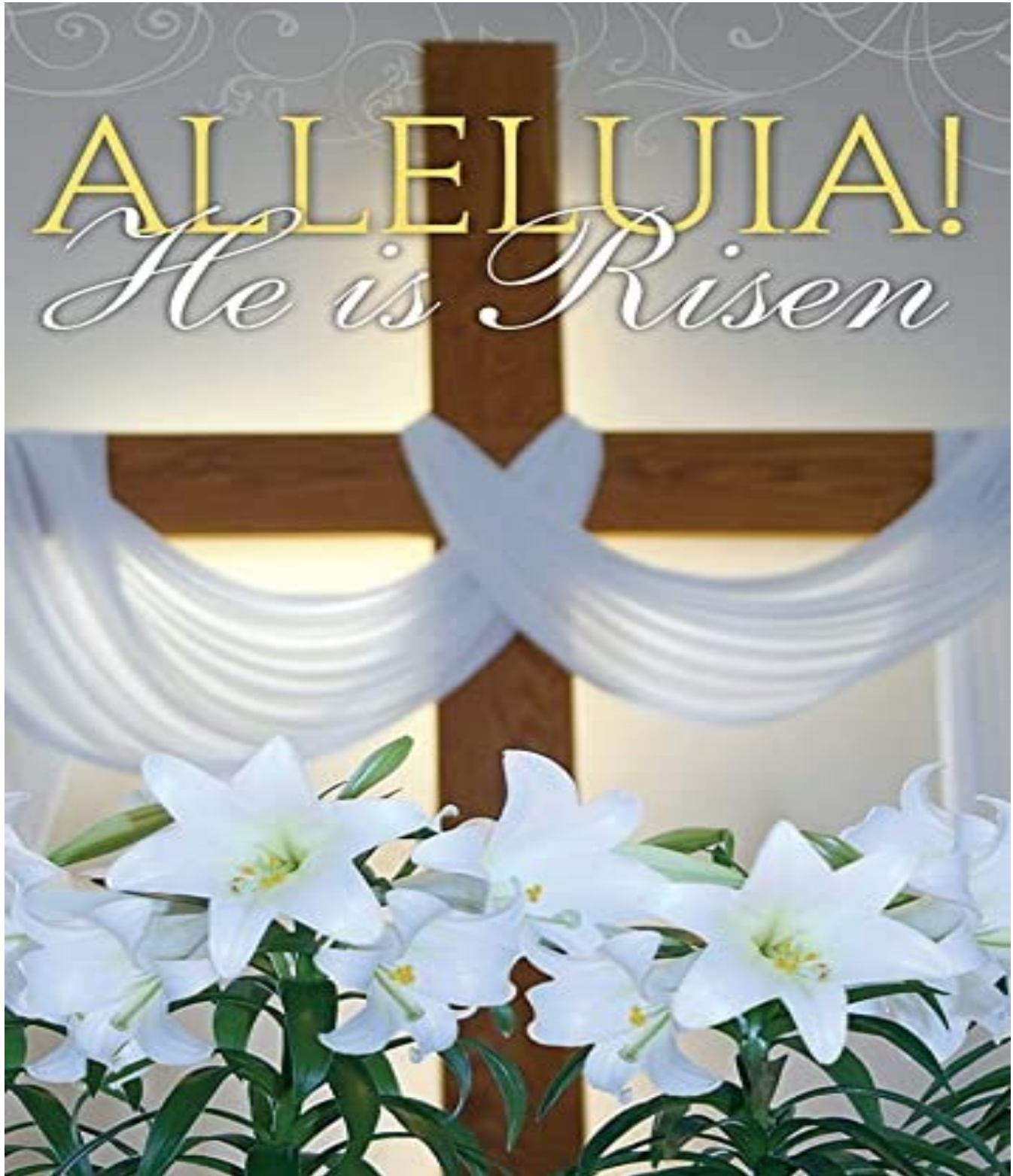

Easter and the Easter Season

Let us rejoice as we celebrate Easter Sunday and the Easter season as we remember the words from Matthew 28:5-6, "Do not be afraid, for I know you seek Jesus who was crucified. He is not here; for he has risen, as he said."

Here is a wonderful description of Easter from the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB):

The word "Easter" comes from Old English, meaning simply the "East." The sun, which rises in the East, bringing light, warmth, and hope, is a symbol for the Christian of the rising Christ, who is the true Light of the world. The Paschal Candle used during the Easter Vigil is a central symbol of this divine light, which is Christ. It is kept near the ambo throughout Easter Time and lit for all liturgical celebrations.

Easter Sunday is the greatest of all Sundays. The season of Easter is the most important of all liturgical times, which Catholics celebrate as the Lord's resurrection from the dead, culminating in his Ascension to the Father and sending of the Holy Spirit upon the Church. The octave of Easter comprises the eight days, which stretch from the first to the second Sunday. It is a way of prolonging the joy of the initial day. There are 50 days of Easter from the first Sunday to Pentecost (this year on May 28th). It is characterized, above all, by the joy of glorified life and the victory over death expressed most fully in the great resounding cry of the Christian: Alleluia! All faith flows from faith in the resurrection: "If Christ has not been raised, then empty is our preaching; empty, too, is your faith." (1 Cor 15:14)

"What you sow is not brought to life unless it dies. And what you sow is not the body that is to be, but a bare kernel of wheat, perhaps, or of some other kind;...So also is the resurrection of the dead. It is sown corruptible; it is raised incorruptible. It is sown dishonorable; it is raised glorious. It is sown weak; it is raised powerful. It is sown a natural body; it is raised a spiritual body. If there is a natural body, there is also a spiritual one. So, too, it is written, "The first man, Adam, became a living being," the last Adam a life-giving spirit. But the spiritual was not first; rather the natural and then the spiritual. The first man was from the earth, earthly; the second man, from heaven. As was the earthly one, so also are the earthly, and as is the heavenly one, so also are the heavenly. Just as we have borne the image of the earthly one, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly one."
(1 Cor 15:36-37, 42-49)

All God's Blessing this Easter season as we remember that Christ died and rose from the dead for each and every one of us.

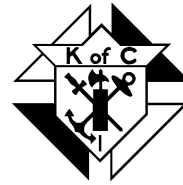

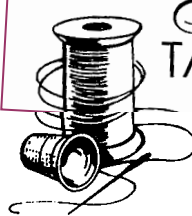

New Adult Study Mystagogy Course

Mystagogy comes from the Greek word meaning, "to lead through the mysteries." The Catechism describes mystagog as a "liturgical catechesis that aims to initiate people into the mystery of Christ".

Mystagogy is typically the fourth stage of RCIA, to enable the newly baptized to continue learning, but most Catholics can benefit from attending these classes. Mystagogy, traditionally extends throughout the Easter season until the feast of Pentecost.

Fr. Marc and Deacon Paul will be leading this course, on Wednesday Evenings at 7:00pm beginning April 19th continuing through May 24th.

Join us and "explore the spiritual treasures contained in the sacraments by reflecting on their meaning and significance in our personal lives of faith".

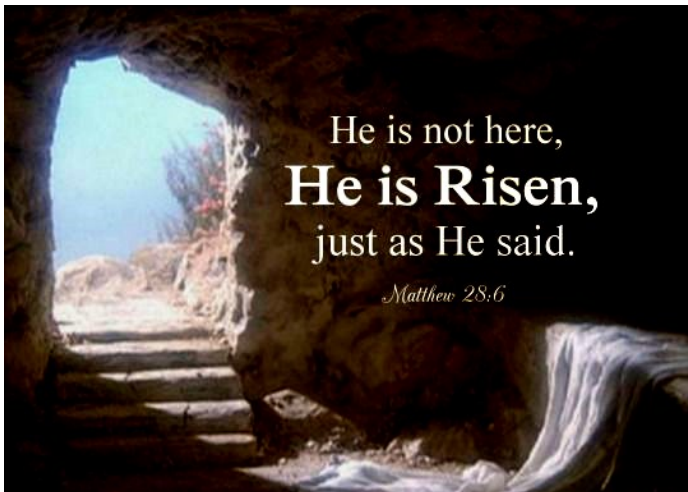
