#### Dear Friends in Christ:

Fourth of July Weekend really sounds like a great 'let your hair down' time of celebration. Remember Labor Day Weekend festivities led to a spike in Coronavirus' contagion because people made poor choices. The virus does not 'take a vacation!' Use common sense, follow protocols with face coverings, sanitation and distancing.

What we are celebrating is the ideal of freedom. What we are struggling from is the tradition of our country's history of freedom denial for African Americans, Asian, Italians, Irish and other groups of people who fall into convenient categories that mark them as being 'different' from the 'in-crowd-White Supremacist' bullies. College fraternity and sororities haze incoming plebes, but they have a time of 'redemption' and 'full acceptance' after 'hell week's painful initiation.' Apprenticeship programs 'temper' the neophyte into a sense of submission to the 'master craftsmen' before being accepted into the 'fraternity' of craftsmen benefits. The point is, submission through humility and acceptance of the hierarchy of achievement is an initiation process. This works traditionally, and productively but slavery never does!

We made a 'declaration of freedom' and then had to win the Revolutionary War to achieve it! Thousands of lives were lost in the process. Our history then cites that we turned around and imposed not only symbolic oppressive taxation on another group, but outright slavery and total dominance and oppression over them for economic gain for ourselves. It was morally wrong at that time and all the other times people have compromised the human dignity of others to suit themselves. Abuse involved subservience, obsequiousness, sexual targeting, dehumanizing punishment and psychological destruction.

THIS 4<sup>th</sup> of July, we have to become the liberators! We have to free ourselves from constricted thinking and recognize EACH person as being a gift from God, created to be free and have a real personal value as a human being! We have to stop making excuses for past generations of wrongdoing and trying to escape ourselves from perpetuating the 'stinking thinking' that justifies continued abuse of others with name calling, targeting for racial slurs, or worse. Let the July 4, 1776 Declaration of Freedom come true in fact July 4, 2020 for all people.


