addressed at any time.



WHATEVER YOU DID FOR THESE LEAST ONES, YOU DID FOR ME

Our Gospel for this Sunday is Matthew's account of the Last Judgment, when Jesus says that the Son of Man will be present at the end of time to separate the sheep from the goats, those who cared for "the least ones" from those who did not. In this Gospel Jesus seems to identify himself with the king and judge as well as with the least ones who were in need.

In contrast, the first reading and the psalm depict God in the role of shepherd. Here it is God who is tending the injured, the strayed, the sick, and the lost. This is what Jesus did throughout his life and by his death. He cared for the hungry, the thirsty, the naked, the ill, and the stranger. He bought freedom for all. Jesus is asking no more and no less from us. The nations will be judged on one criterion only: whether we imitated the compassion of God that was revealed to us in Jesus, whether we recognized the suffering face of Jesus in the least ones and responded with love.

Dear Friends in Christ:

To acknowledge Jesus as Christ, the King of the Universe, is to boldly state 'there is No Other' than He Who IS. God is God. When we choose to be centered on Christ, we become more conscious of God's Presence in our lives. We can, indeed, talk with Him, walk with Him, and listen to His Presence always. St. Paul said, "Pray always!" That didn't mean, say prayers, but certainly means, to take comfort in your relationship with Jesus always! Communicate with Jesus your love, satisfaction, sense of purpose and trust. When we accept Jesus as "Lord" there is no limit to that acceptance. It is universal in our personal experience and without boundaries in our humanity experience, terrestrial and extraterrestrial!

On Sunday evening, four astronauts were launched into orbit to link up with the Space Station in an ongoing but nascent trek for humanity to reach out from the limits of earth and 'go where no one has gone before...' except for Christ, the King of the Universe – who is there all the time, waiting for us to connect with Him here, there, everywhere! 




In addition, we will need a volunteer to organize the outside drive thru line, and someone to organize the gym area where meals will be assembled.
