Deacon's Corner June 20, 2021

First, I would like to express my great appreciation for the welcome provided for me, my wife Joanie, and our family that we received during our first weekend at St. Lawrence and St. Philip. We are looking forward to humbly serve this Catholic community.

Additionally, I receive a daily e-mail on the Catholic saint of the day. I have grown to appreciate this short daily history of each saint. Of course, we think saints are perfect and live the perfect lives. But I have come to understand that saints are not perfect people; they are faithful and prayerful people.

Appropriately, I want to share a brief history of St. Lawrence and St. Philip for my first Deacon's Corner. St. Lawrence was a deacon in Rome in the Third Century. He was responsible for the material goods of the Church and the distribution of alms to the poor. When he knew he would be arrested, St. Lawrence distributed all that he had on hand to the poor, including selling some of the sacred vessels of the altar to have more to distribute. The prefect of Rome heard of this wanted St. Lawrence to render the Church treasures to Caesar. St. Lawrence requested three days to collect these treasures. When the prefect appeared, St. Lawrence presented him with a significant number of blind, lame, maimed, leprous, orphaned, and widowed persons and said, "These are the treasures of the Church." For this, he was martyred on a gridiron over hot coals, and legend concludes he made his famous cheerful remark, "It is well done. Turn me over!"

Also, St. Philip was one of the apostles of Christ. In the Gospel of John, Jesus asks Philip where they should buy bread to feed the multitudes, and Philip answers, "Two hundred days' wages worth of food would not be enough for each of them to have a little." Later in John's Gospel, Philip said, "Master show us the Father, and that will be enough for us." Jesus answered, "Have I been with you for so long a time, and you still do not know me, Philip? Whoever has seen me has seen the Father."

Overall, we are all called to be saints in our unique path in life. May you have a blessed week as you think of a particular saint you know or the quiet saints who live among us.

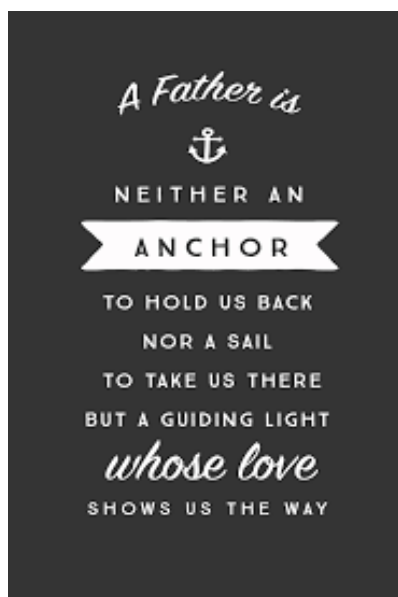

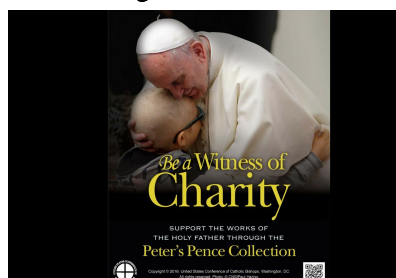
