


### **ROOTED IN BAPTISM**

Today gives us the opportunity to take the time to pray for those who lead us in ordained ministry. In this time of crisis in the Church, our bishops, deacons, and priests need our support as they continue to embrace their vocation to do as Saint Peter did-to point others to the Lord. Since all vocations are rooted in the sacrament of baptism, it is good for us to remember that it was at the moment of our baptism that we became Christ for others. Each of us is called to become more and more like the Good Shepherd as we learn to live out our baptismal call. As we make our way along the Christian journey, we need nourishment and guidance from those appointed to be our shepherds. We need to pray that God will strengthen those who have become weary. On this Good Shepherd Sunday, let us pray especially for the ordained and all those called to point us to the Lord.

Dear Friends in Christ:

When Jesus used the metaphor of the Good Shepherd, he wasn't talking about the sheep! He was addressing the role of the shepherd. The leader, the Apostle, the Disciple of Christ gives faithful witness to the faith in all things. It is a conscious awareness that the Gospel applies to everything! As a conscientious leader in the faith, it is your and my serious mandate to follow the Gospel always. Do we do that as Good Shepherds?

Where there is racial intolerance do we stand silently by? Do we tolerate hate speech against Italians, Asians, Blacks, or even Irish? Do we challenge the presumption! There have been 48 mass shootings in our country this year. How do we stand up to temper flair ups? Do we get overly simplistic about gun control? Do we tolerate elected officials being drama queens over significant issues or do we hold them to a higher standard of common sense, research data and logical reasoning?

To be a Good Shepherd, we have to challenge negative assumptions! We have to call out those who denigrate! We need to sift through the presumptions and search out truth. Even though you and I live in a community where there are few minorities, we have to be more perceptive and recognize intolerance. As Catholics, we have to stand together for the right reasons. Bigotry is wrong in any way we look at it.

Pause for effect when you hear something that just doesn't sound right. Quietly question the presumption about someone's opinion. Point out the fault without relying on bigoted opinions. Raise the standard. Don't stand idly by when you perceive the line was crossed. Be the Good Shepherd!
