Deacon's Corner

November 7, 2021

Vocations

The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) has designated November 7-13 as National Vocations Awareness Week. It is a week dedicated to promoting vocations to the priesthood, diaconate, and consecrated life through prayer and education. Also, every Catholic is encouraged to renew our prayers and support for those who are considering one of these vocations. It is thus essential to pray for those considering the priesthood.

Additionally, one may ask why are vocations to the priesthood so important? It comes down to the simple fact that there is no consecration of the Eucharist or Mass without a priest.

With the number of seminarians declining in various areas around the country, this is enough reason to pray for vocations. For example, the Erie Diocese's St. Mark Seminary has only six young men in formation; four from the Diocese of Greensburg, one from the Diocese of Altoona – Johnstown, and one from the Diocese of Erie. The Diocese of Erie has eight men in the major seminary at St. Vincent Seminary and St. Mary Seminary & University. This includes Chris Wheeler, who has already been ordained a transition deacon and is in his 4th and final year at St. Vincent Seminary.

Each of us consequently needs to encourage the many young people in our lives to pray and discern what God is calling them to do. There are quite a few examples of people who are now priests or religious recalling a time when someone suggested they consider a religious vocation.

Here is a pray for vocations from the USCCB to get you started:

God our Father,

We thank you for calling men and women to serve in your Son's Kingdom as priests, deacons, and consecrated persons.

Send your Holy Spirit to help others to respond generously and courageously to your call.

May our community of faith support vocations of sacrificial love in our youth and young adults.

Through our Lord Jesus Christ, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, forever and ever. Amen

Remember to spend some time this week praying for vocations to the priesthood and religious life.
