Pastor's Desk**



Dear Friends in Christ:

1. It's such a positive experience to see fathers guiding their children, giving positive role modeling to them about the quality of adult living and truly loving them and affirming them. We celebrate "Father's Day" because young boys and girls, youth and adults alike, have an inner need to have durable, loving, role models in their 'parenting.' There are so many parents who ignore, give bad examples to and even overtly abuse their children. They are lighting the fuses of future explosive anger, low self-esteem, and problematic lives. SCI-Albion and other prisons are *filled* with men and women who learned negativity from their parents and carried it over into overt criminal behavior.

Diminishing future prison populations, increasing committed college and technical skill development and productivity in craftsmanship, faithfulness to religious values and moral living rest heavily on the young person's positive experience with loving mothers and fathers. An old adage: "The hand that rocks the cradle, rules the world" clearly reflects the importance of positive parenting for long-term positive living.

2. Focusing on our teaching that God IS Trinity encourages us to have a deep appreciation for the true mystery of God. Mystery is 'good' because when we take time to enter into that special relationship, we don't have 'all the answers.' We are dependent on mystery – dynamic relationship filled with awe and wonder. This relationship alone is 'truly awesome.' A hamburger is not! A pizza is not! God, and God alone, One God, Trinity ALONE is awesome!! "Worthy of total and complete AWE!!"

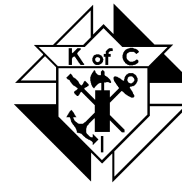

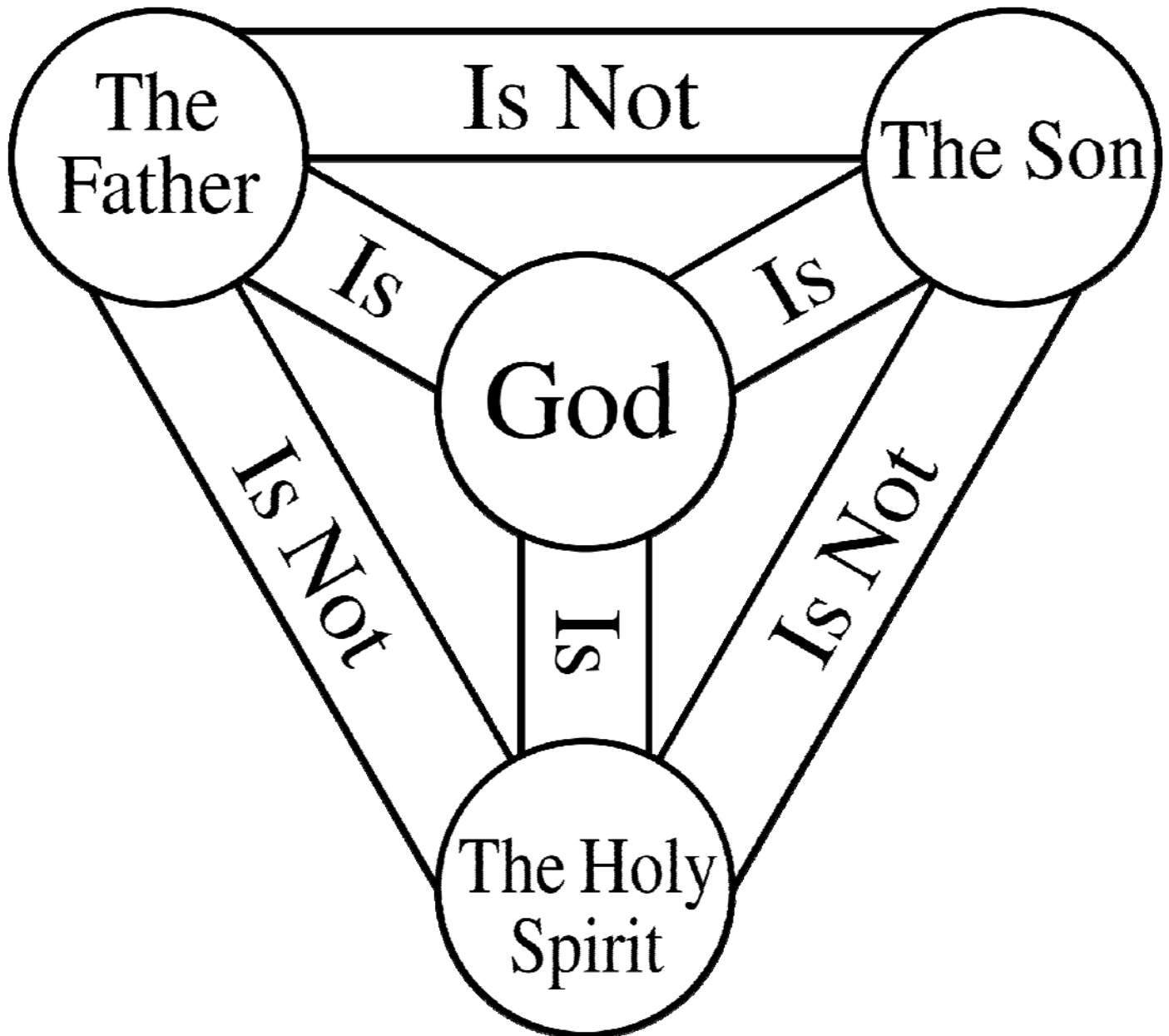
