The Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph

This weekend at Mass, we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. It is observed on the first Sunday after Christmas. Veneration of the Holy Family gained popularity during the 1490s. Later, Italian and Flemish Renaissance painters in the 15th and 16th centuries became fascinated with the Holy Family as subjects of their artwork.

The Feast of the Holy Family has been a liturgical celebration in the Catholic Church since 1921, when Pope Benedict XV added it to the church's calendar. In 1969, this feast day was added to the General Roman Calendar for celebration during the season of Christmastide or Christmas time.

Also, The Feast of the Holy Family provides a day to reflect on our own family life. A day to heal past wounds and strengthen communications between all our family members.

Another excellent way to celebrate this holy day would be to reach out with your time, talent, and treasures to help family support charitable organizations like the Catholic Charities of the Dioceses of Erie.
