Deacon's Corner

May 8, 2022

Our Lady of Fatima

This Friday, May 13th, the Church celebrates Our Lady of Fatima. Between May 13th and October 13th, 1917, three Portuguese children witnessed apparitions of Our Lady at Cova da Iria near Fatima, a city 110 miles north of Lisbon. Mary asked the children to pray the Rosary for world peace, for the end of World War I, and for sinners. This is probably among the most well-known Marian apparitions.

In the spring of 1917, Francisco and Jacinta Marto and their cousin Lucia dos Santos were playing and building castles out of rock in the field. Then, they saw a lady dressed in white more brilliant than the sun by a small holm oak tree. She said, "Don't be afraid. I won't hurt you! I am from Heaven. I come to ask you to come here for six months in succession, on the thirteenth day at this same hour. Then I will tell who I am and what I want." The Lady also told the children, "Say the Rosary every day to obtain peace for the world and end of the war."

After returning home, Jacinta told her mother about her experience. News spread quickly around the village, exposing the children to ridicule and disbelief. During the July 13th appearance, Lucia asked the Lady for a miracle to prove Her appearances to people who doubted. The Lady responded, "Continue to come here every month. In October, I will tell you who I am, what I wish, and perform a miracle that everyone will believe." October 13th was a very rainy day, but an estimated crowd of 70,000 was present to witness the miracle the Lady had promised. She appeared and said, "I am the Lady of the Rosary. Continue to say the Rosary every day and build a chapel here in My honor." The crowds then saw the sun start to dance in the sky, whirl rapidly, and emit flames of fire reflecting many colors. Many people were frightened, and some thought it was the end of the world. When the sun returned to normal, the ground and all of the peoples' clothing were dry.

The local bishop approved the feast of our Lady of Fatima in 1930, and it was added to the Church's worldwide calendar in 2002.

Mary's appearances and private revelation to the three children at Fatima were not to draw attention to herself but to point to the mercy of her son Jesus Christ. As Catholics, we do not worship Mary, but we ask her to intercede for us with Jesus. We can do that by pray and especially reciting the mysteries of the Holy Rosary.
