

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

On August 15th, the Church celebrates the solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This important feast day recalls the spiritual and physical departure of the mother of Jesus Christ from the earth when both her soul and body were taken into the presence of God.

Pope Pius XII issued the Apostolic Constitution "Munificentissimus Deus," or "Most Bountiful God" in 1950. It invoked papal infallibility and proclaimed, "We pronounce, declare and define it to be a divinely revealed dogma that the immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul to heavenly glory." The pope proclaimed this dogma only after a broad consultation of bishops, theologians, and laity. There were few dissenting voices. What the pope solemnly declared was already a common belief in the Catholic Church. We find homilies on the Assumption going back to the sixth century. The feast was celebrated under various names, including Commemoration, Dormition, Passing, and Assumption. Today it is celebrated as a solemnity, a feast day of the highest rank celebrating a mystery of faith.

Although Mary's bodily assumption is not explicitly mentioned in scripture, Catholic tradition identifies her with the "woman clothed with the sun," as described in Chapter 12 of the Book of Revelation.


There are many different traditions for celebrating the Assumption. In Poland, the day is known as the Feast of Our Lady of Herbs, with bouquets made of blossoms and herbs taken to church. Parades with marching bands, funfairs, games, races, costume contests, dancing, and other family-friendly events occur throughout Spain. In some parts of France, there is a custom of proposing marriage on August 15th, when the couple can ask Mary to specially bless their future together. In Armenia, there is a custom of offering the "first fruits" of the harvest to God in imitation of the Biblical Abel, who made the same worthy sacrifice. So, the Sunday nearest to the Feast of the Assumption is set aside for the Blessing of the Grapes.

Hail Mary, Full of Grace, The Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners now, and at the hour of our death. Amen.




