Dear Friends in Christ:

Consistently, Jesus prays for closeness with his followers in the Gospel accounts. There is no question that he is establishing a living, personal relationship with us. Are we doing our part to keep that relationship alive? He trusts us with one another and he trusts us that we will nourish our relationship with him.

Do you talk with Jesus every day? Is there room in your schedule for him? Or is he sitting aside waiting for you to slow down and communicate? If you schedule personal prayer every day at a given time and place, he will be happily waiting for you. If your prayer conversation is random, spontaneous, spur of the moment, perhaps Jesus will be engaged elsewhere. Schedule, ritual, personal scheduling matters for what is important in our lives.

As Catholics, we form routines in prayer and ritual. Rosary, novena, adoration and other prayer experiences are important to us. During Pandemic, the need for us to make time for these events to happen is even greater. We have to be self-motivating. Make a choice to pray, then follow a set pattern of doing so. Go to the cemetery and remember the dead. Converse with them and pray for them. Prayer crosses all boundaries of time, place, person and opportunity.

When you sit on the porch with a mug of coffee, talk with God. Think about your children, your parents, and pray for their well-being. When you are sorting things out in your garage, sort out your thoughts as well and pray for people who need special help. There are many moments in our daily lives that can become moments of prayer. St. Paul said: "Pray always." He wanted us to have an appreciation of the commonness of prayerful experience not as an extraordinary experience but within the ordinariness of our daily life.
