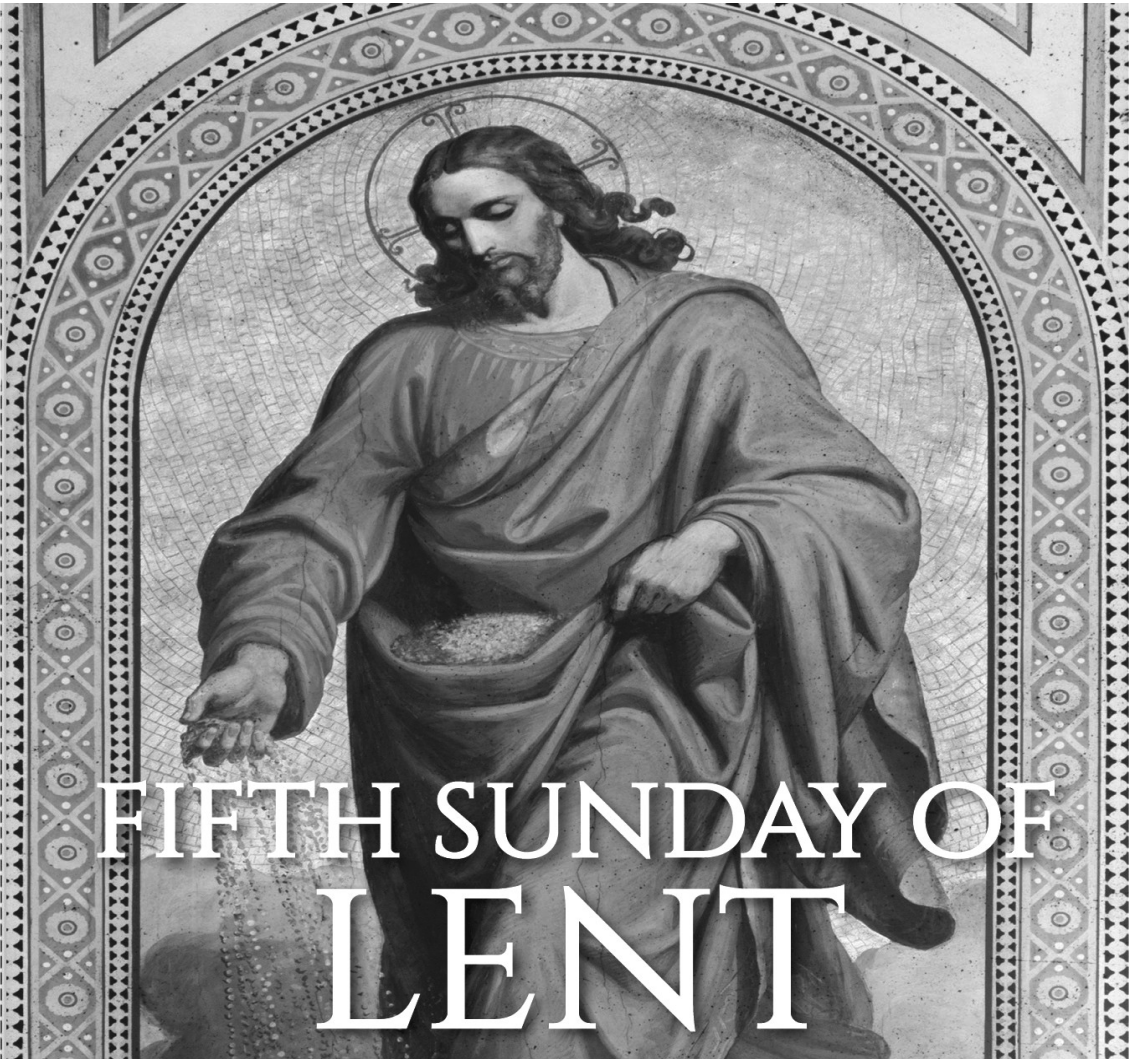

From the
Pastor's Desk



Dear Friends in Christ:

When Jesus used the metaphor of referring to himself as a 'grain of wheat,' he was focusing on dying, being transformed, and rising to be the source of life. It is a Eucharistic theme. The people he was serving were based on simple needs – mostly bread for their staple nourishment. That doesn't translate into hamburger, or French fries. The diet for primitive people was primitive – based on grain. For a neighbor to ask for a couple of loaves of bread to feed visiting relatives or friends in the middle of the night was to seek a staple food to share in community. At that time, the rules of sharing, isolation were very different than of today. For friends or relatives to gather was an occasion for the neighborhood to share.

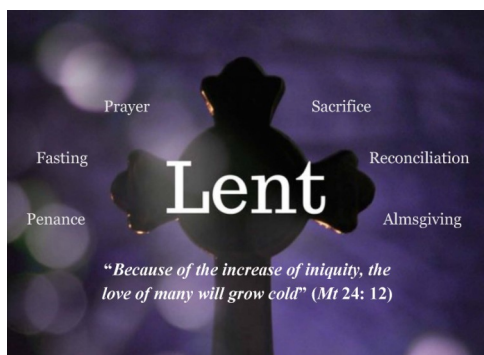
So Jesus was calling people to community with his notion of sharing bread, sharing communal meals, with himself as being the central theme or consciousness! Take and eat – Take and drink – This is my body – This is my blood. The community of faith gathers, becomes aware of the reality of oneness and the coming into being as a conscious, living reality!
