

Before Advent in the Deacon's Corner, I started going through 9 rules for living joy with a different rule each week. I ended on rule 4.

Chris Stefanick describes these rules in the book, Living Joy: 9 Rules to Help You Rediscover and Live Joy Every Day. The book is an urgently needed message for a world grasping for joy but settling for short-lived pleasures. Chris Stefanick does a remarkable job at leading the reader on a journey to encounter joy with his humor and insights from daily living the faith. God made us for joy.

As a reminder, here are the 9 rules:

- Rule 1 Give Thanks
- Rule 2 Practice Silence
- Rule 3 Love Yourself
- Rule 4 Have Fun
- Rule 5 Engage Your Body in the Battle for Joy
- Rule 6 Make Friends
- Rule 7 Rest
- Rule 8 Serve
- Rule 9 Frame Your Mind with Faith

This week we will pick up and have look in greater detail at <u>Rule 5 – Engage Your Body in the Battle for Joy</u>. As "spiritual" as we may be, we are not pure spirit but a "body-soul composite." We can engage our bodies in three ways:

- Change Your Position, Change Your Disposition You should not just be a thermometer gauging
 the temperature of a room. You should be a thermostat setting the temperature. Put a smile on,
 back straight, shoulders back, and chest out. You are there to bless others as a son or daughter
 of God, King of the Universe. Mother Teresa said, "If you want to love God, act like you love
 God."
- 2. <u>Smile More</u> "He is risen. Tell your face. If we believe the best news in human history, it should shine on our faces." A smile isn't just an expression of joy, but a source of joy. Mother Teresa said, "We shall never know all the good that a simple smile can do."
- 3. <u>Exercise</u> "Exercise kicks off a whole concoction of happy-making neurological and hormonal processes that make our lives not only longer but also more enjoyable." Any type of exercise is powerful. Plain and simple. In addition to exercise, sleep is essential. If you are frustrated, a nap can be the change you need to take a fresh look at a problem. "Sleep is a weapon. If you want to fight for your joy, be sure to use it."
