Pastor's Desk**



Dear Friends in Christ:

The faith of the disciples is a mix of common human check and balance and inter-personal relationship with Jesus. They were sent out 2 by 2 – never alone... and called to community. Jesus never worked one on one... always in couples and community. When he worked a miracle, Jesus called special disciples together to witness it, or he did it in public, connecting the casual community present to give witness, to tell his story. He did not have exclusive presence with anyone through the Gospel narratives.

The same is true today. Jesus comes that we might be bold and give witness to our faith. Have you done so lately? It's God's will that you do. What do you believe, why do you believe it, how can it be a positive witness to others? Ours is not a passive faith, but an active one. Parents who do not bring their children to Mass and pray with them, give bad examples of adult faith. As we take responsibility for giving good witness to others, let us start with our own community.

People are returning to Church for worship. Are you among them? I hope so. It is good to be together on Sunday or Saturday night every week. We all need the witness and presence you bring when you come to pray.

Deacon's Corner

I am reading a very thought-provoking book, *The Pivotal Players – 12 Heroes Who Shaped the Church and Changed the World* by Bishop Robert Barron. This book is just one of the many excellent resources available from the Word on Fire Catholic Ministries. Each chapter has the person's history, a description of their talents or works, and closes with why Bishop Barron thinks this person is a pivotal player. Robert Barron says, "The men and women under consideration in this book are those who entered with particular creativity, intelligence, and abandon into the life of Christ – those who played the Christian game remarkably well."

The list has men and women, saints, artists, preachers, writers, and converts to the Catholic faith. Some you may have known about already, while others are more obscure. So here is Bishop Barron's list: St. Augustine, St. Benedict, St. Francis of Assisi, St. Thomas Aquinas, St. Catherine of Siena, Michelangelo, Bartolomé de las Casas, St. Ignatius of Loyola, St. John Henry Newman, G.K. Chesterton, Fulton J. Sheen, and Flannery O'Connor.

In the last chapter of the book, Robert Barron writes, "There are new saints being raised up right now, who in future generations will be recognized as pivotal players of the twenty-first century. It might be you or me, in God's providence – it might be someone who you or I help to come into the Church, or someone we encourage, or teach, or pray for, or serve. Each and every one of us is a pivotal player for someone in our lives. Let us live out that calling, with God's help and the help of all the saints!"
