**Deacon's Corner**  
**November 13, 2022**

Saint Frances Xavier Cabrini

November 13<sup>th</sup> is the day the Church remembers Saint Frances Xavier Cabrini. Francis Cabrini was the youngest of thirteen children and was born on July 15, 1850, in a small village called S'ant Angelo Lodigiano near Milan, Italy. She grew up enthralled by the stories of missionaries and determined to join a religious order. But unfortunately, her frail health prevented her from being able to join the Daughters of the Sacred Heart, under who she obtained her teaching certificate.

Undeterred, Frances founded her own order, the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, in 1880. She and her sisters wanted to be missionaries in China. Frances obtained an audience with Pope Leo XIII, who told her to go “not East, but West” to New York. She was to help the thousands of Italian immigrants already in the United States.

Mother Cabrini and her sister companions arrive in New York, which seemed to be filled with chaos and poverty. She organized catechism and education classes for Italian immigrants and provided for many orphans’ needs. She established schools and orphanages despite tremendous odds.

Mother Francis Cabrini soon had requests from all over the world to open schools. So, she traveled to Europe, Central and South America, and the United States. In 35 years, Francis made 23 trans-Atlantic crossings and established 67 schools, hospitals, and orphanages. Her travel over the Atlantic is an example of answering God’s call since she was always frightened of water and drowning from when she was a child.

Mother died of malaria in her own Columbus Hospital in Chicago in December 1917. In 1946 she was canonized a saint by Pope Pius XIII in recognition of her holiness and service to mankind. Saint Frances Xavier Cabrini has the distinction of being the first United States citizen to be canonized,
