

<u>Rule 7: Rest</u>

This week, let's continue to look at the book Living Joy: 9 Rules to Help You Rediscover and Live Joy Every Day by Chris Stefanick. Rule 7: Rest.

Chris Stefanick tells us, "You can't have joy without resting from your work." The command to rest and worship on the Sabbath changed the world. Like worship, rest isn't handed to you. You need to fight for it. A life absorbed by work and endless tasks can rob you of more than your time. "If you're not careful, it robs you of your sense of self. It feels like slavery."

Chris reminds us that "We aren't human do-ings. We are human be-ings." We matter and have dignity and rights. Our identity should be more than our job title. "We are more than the things we do or the roles we play."

The Sabbath is about learning to rest in the eternal now. "You work so hard to 'grow up,' and then you work for your job, then marriage; then while you're married, you work for a kid; then when your kids come along, you're working for a more stable life; and once you've got that you work for your retirement. The forward motion never stops." You should still make plans and work for the future but still live each moment of the life journey. To start enjoying life.

Chris Stefanick outlines three ways to help you learn to rest:

- <u>Wage war on work, one day every week</u> Doing nothing is hard since we always want to do something. Learn to rest even if the work is not done. The tasks will still be there later. Segment your life, "When it's time to work, work. When it's time to stop and enjoy your family, stop working and enjoy your family."
- <u>Savor moments</u> Stop and smell the roses. Enjoy the little things. Take time to taste your food even if it is fast food. Enjoy what you have, and stop dreaming about what you want. "You don't need to be rich to live like a king." Learn to enjoy God's abundant gifts.
- 3. **Don't rest lazily** Rest is serious business. "Rest is a deep, intentional dive into life." During rest, don't just fill up the time with mind-numbing distractions. "It's your job to guide your heart and mind to things that lift you up and fuel your joy.

Take some time this week to rest. This is also a great time to rest in quiet prayer.
