Dear Friends in Christ:

COVID continues – be careful and follow CDC guidelines for your safety, your family's safety and bring a positive attitude towards our community's choice to follow safety protocols. We continue to welcome members to gather for Mass at St. Lawrence and St. Philip. We follow distancing protocols, mask wearing and refrain from unhealthy congregating in close proximity. In addition, Jim is <u>'fogging'</u> the church with a 'mist-fog' sanitization device to add a substantial protective process. It is a good thing to experience people gathering in the church to celebrate Mass.

As reported in our weekly parish bulletin, both our <u>CSA and Offertory Collections</u> are falling short of assessment and budgeted parish obligations. Ours is not a 'wealthy' parish, and everyone's 'fair share' is badly needed for us to be solvent as a faith community. Whatever you can do to 'narrow the gap' would be an essential improvement in our financial obligations as a parish.

If we have an <u>October Dinner</u>, it will be necessary for people committed to this event to have a meeting really soon. This annual fund raiser is an essential one in the best of circumstances. Can we gather on <u>Thursday evening</u>, <u>September 10</u>, <u>from 7:00 to 8:00</u> to discuss this event? We cannot wait any longer to define the possibilities of what to do, if anything, to bring this fund raiser about.

We are still 'on hold' with respect to resuming Bingo. Currently, the hall is designed to hold as many as 60 – 65 players while maintaining necessary distancing. We have a current plan for sanitization, controlling movement, masking and 'fogging' to ensure safety within reasonable protocols. Current 'gathering' limitations of 25 still restrict our reopening to accommodate a working crowd of players.

Finally, our <u>Faith Formation Program</u> is being adjusted to accommodate sanitization protocols for our faculty, parents and students. A lot of time and thought is invested in caring for the safety and educational details for our program this year. Parents are essential support and leader personnel for establishing a 'family-based' faith formation. The Catholic Faith is an essential ingredient for positive community development and faith identity maturing. Let us work these experiences together as a family of faith truly committed to Jesus and His Gospel of Faith, Hope and Love and Sacramental experience of His Presence in our lives.




