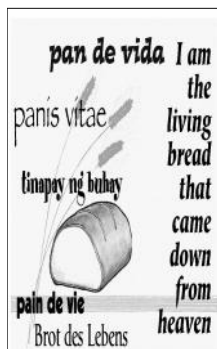

From the Pastor's Desk



Dear Friends in Christ:

Contrary to Protestant Christians who gather to pray, sing, reflect on Sacred Readings and receive symbolic wine/grape juice and unleavened bread, we gather to pray, sing, reflect on Sacred Readings and receive the True Body and Blood and Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ. It is not simply a symbolic gesture, but a real and true sharing in the Last Supper. Jesus said: "Do this in memory of Me!" It was not a suggestion, but a command. As Catholics, we take that literally: "Do this..."

Our part is to prepare for Holy Communion by confessing our sins, doing positive ministry, promoting the Gospel message to others and then receive spiritual nourishment by eating and drinking at the 'table of the Lord.' We have to take responsibility to express respect, reverence towards Christ in the Eucharist and Christ within each person we meet. As members of the *Mystical Body of Christ*, the Church, we are living witnesses of Christ's Presence in the world. When we gather in Christ's Name, he said: "I AM with you!" When we listen reverently to the Holy Gospel, we hear Christ Himself being Proclaimed. When we receive the Holy Eucharist we receive the Real Presence of Christ as well. Christ is 'really Present' in the gathering, the proclamation of the Gospel, and in the consecrated Host and Wine of Salvation!

We are never alone unless we choose to separate from the Sacred Meal, the gathering of the community of faith, or the attending to the dynamic sacred text of the Holy Scripture. Corpus Christ, the Body of Christ comes to us, nourishes us, and IS us when we minister in His Name.

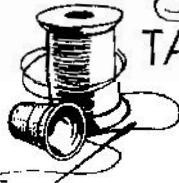

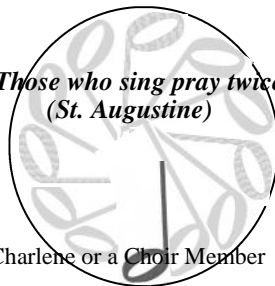
