From the
Pastor's Desk



Dear Friends in Christ:

Bingo has provided our parish with substantial, hard earned income. A handful of dedicated, elderly people have worked valiantly for many Monday nights to provide for social enjoyment and fun gatherings at St. Lawrence Center. Despite repeated requests for additional support staff for the good of the parish in this enjoyable and community building fund-raising venture, younger volunteers have not come forward.

With the Pandemic's threat to older people, especially, the Bingo staff understandably feels ill at ease being the only workers because of their physical limitations, being in the 'high threat population' for Coronavirus infection, resuming Bingo in the immediate future is not going to happen. With the county medical limitations allowing for us to open up this month, one suggestion was to give it another month or wait to the beginning of the New Year. Both are arbitrary and capricious suggestions with no merit.

Even with county regulations opening up for Bingo activities, we still have the fundamental problem of risking our elderly staff who have health issues already and we have no 'depth' of volunteers to help out. Even with practicing safety protocols such as wearing masks, temperature taking of all entering the hall, and fogging the environment, the lack of adequate staff remains the obvious obstacle.

Bingo is a Parish fund-raising activity that brings parish members together to provide for community building and brings customers together to provide for social outlet and mature entertainment. We have succeeded at each of these goals! Thank you to all who have come together to enjoy this work and play that has benefitted our parish's financial support!

The lack of adequate support staff to maintain this activity is an unsurmountable obstacle. I am currently investigating the possibility of selling our Bingo equipment and supplies, recover what we can receive to offset obvious losses, and close down the Bingo activity permanently. To all who have sacrificed and committed to the activity for the past many, many months... much gratitude and appreciation, your hard work has clearly helped St. Lawrence and St. Philip with financial blessings to meet our utilities and basic operating expenses. Bingo income was not a superficial one. It compensated for our descending Offertory and CSA obligations. Where we go from here is a fearful speculation. Pray about it and when you come up with some positive notions, let's meet and talk about our future.
