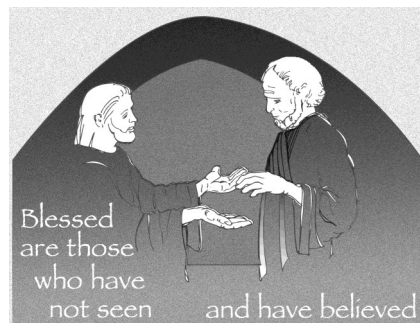

PEACE

Throughout the liturgical year we focus on the words, actions, and miracles of Jesus as he moved from town to town. Today we focus especially on the first word of the Risen One as he greeted the disciples on the evening of that first Easter: “Peace.” The first word from the mouth of God’s Son—who had been unfairly tried, who had been beaten and spit upon, whose hands and feet were nailed to a tree, who suffered enormous pain in that torturous death—was the word “Peace.” Not “Revenge!” Not “Retribution!” Not “Kill!” “Peace.”





Dear Friends in Christ:

In the Easter Season especially, we have to be more aware of the impact our words and deeds have on people around us. Take care of what you say and do. It is all too common in our society that we denigrate people of other ethnic groups, women, and heavy set people of all nationalities. Whatever our prejudice, we become conscious all too quickly.

Our national consciousness is pricked by demonstrations, name calling, character assassinations. Too many of us stand back in horror as others speak out prejudice comments and label others according to our own personal prejudices. Black people, Brown people, Asian people, Indian people are people, deserving of recognition. Despite their language barriers, despite their cultural differences, these people deserve the same respect we give our own – no more, no less.

Jesus directed His Disciples to go forth and to proclaim the Gospel to ALL nations. The community of believers in the Acts of the Apostles was made up of many different people – all equally present, all equally accepted. Live the Joy of the Gospel and be hospitable to all People, seeing Christ within them.
