

#### Six Powerful Spiritual Lessons

This week I thought it would be worthwhile to return to Mathew Kelly's book, "I Heard God Laugh." Kelly talks about six seismic shifts we experience as we continue focusing on our pray life. Prayer helps us make the longest of journeys from head to heart. Even after 30 years of being Catholic, I find days I look forward to prayer and other days I have to force myself to keep showing up.

Here is a brief description of six powerful spiritual lessons we can learn through prayer.

- 1.<u>Begin the Conversation</u> Prayer is a conversation like that with a friend or family member. Just begin the conversation. Once the conversation starts, it can lead anywhere. It can lead to the places we need to go.
- 2.<u>Ask God What He Wants</u> We often ask God for our many needs and wants. Maybe we could stop and ask God what we should do in a particular situation at home, work, or school. "God, what do you think I should do with the rest of my life?"
- 3. <u>Give Yourself to Prayer</u> "Giving yourself to prayer means showing up and letting God do what he wants to do with you during that time of prayer." Focus on "letting go" and "being" in the moment.
- 4.<u>Transform Everything into Prayer</u> God is with us in each moment. Every moment is a precious gift. God is with us in the ordinary moments of life washing dishes, mowing the lawn, commuting to work, paying the bills, having dinner with the family, talking to your children, and spending time with a friend. This is probably what St. Paul means when he says, "Pray constantly." God wants you to take him along to every activity throughout the day.
- 5.<u>Make Yourself Available</u> "We need so little, but we burden ourselves with so much." The unnecessary things can create obstacles between God and us. Try giving away or donating some of the "stuff" you thought was important but have not used in years. "We crowd God out of our lives by filling our lives with things that don't matter." Think about what you really need.
- 6.<u>Just Keep Showing Up</u> It may not be convenient to pray, or you may just not feel like it. "Prayer isn't about feelings." "Just show up and let God work on you."

Matthew Kelly writes, "These six significant moments are markers along the way in your sacred journey. But your journey will be as unique and different as a sunset. No two are the same." Don't worry if you are doing well in one of the spiritual lessons and then find yourself returning to past habits and thoughts. "Along the way, be mindful that the spiritual life is not a straight line." We will find ourselves taking steps forward and back.

All God's blessing as you continue your lifelong journey in prayer.
