

# From the Pastor's Desk

My dear parish family:

# **REDISCOVERING THE SACRAMENTS (Part 7 of 7)** Holy Orders: Called to Serve, Not be Served

If you have ever attended the ordination of a deacon, priest or bishop, following the man's promises of obedience to the Church, the presiding bishop says this: "May God who has begun the good work in you bring it to fulfillment." This is a wonderful prayer for all seven sacraments, because our lives of faith are built upon being recipients of God's grace so that we can do His works – good works. Indeed this is the life of every Christian – of every Catholic, but in a special way we encounter those called to serve as priests, religious sisters and deacons. This life is not for everyone, but those of us who live it (myself and Deacon Larry) we can say that is, if I may use a famous movie title, "a wonderful life!"

But the wonderful life of any vocation – single life, marriage, religious life – begins at home. I found the strength and trust to follow Christ as a priest in my own life because of the example of my parents and grandparents. I saw that God was an inseparable part of their day to day lives. Mass on Sundays and Holy Days was NOT optional. Our faith was the beginning and the end of our family. We must reignite that fire of faith in our homes, so that our young people are not lost in darkness, but follow the light of Christ.

Many priests, religious and deacons will say that it was their home parish community that greatly encouraged them and it was there that God's voice was the loudest. Together we must encourage vocations – all vocations – but especially to religious life. The Vatican recently released that the number of priests was increasing – but not enough. There is a hunger out there in the world - a hunger for purpose, for love, for  $\hat{G}$ od. I can already see in the young men and women of our parishes that they want God in their lives. I pray that one of them one day soon will come to me and say, "Father Justin, I want to be a priest. I want to a religious sister. I want to live my life for others. I never want to be separated from God." My hope for those conversations continues. If you see someone who you think who make a good, holy and dedicated servant for the Church – TELL THEM – TELL ME and together we can build up God's kingdom.



Holy Orders is a sacrament of service. Holy Orders is a sacrament of sacrifice. On the day of my ordination I laid on the marble floor of St. Peter's Cathedral, crying my eyes out, to the point of a visible puddle of tears collected on the floor before me. They were not tears of sadness – that I had lost something. No! They were tears of sacrificial joy – that Christ chose me, as weak and imperfect as I am, to be Him for others – for you. He gave me so much at that moment and continues to do so.

I hope I have been Christ for you in these past months, because every time I baptize one of your children, every time you and I experience God's mercy in the confessions, every time the Holy Spirit allows me to

confect the Holy Eucharist and share it with you, every time two of you become one in marriage before my eyes, every time I anoint your foreheads and hands with oil, every time I witness the outpouring of God's love in a new priest, sister or deacon – after all that I know that we are one! We are together on the same journey. We are a sacramental people that must depend on God no matter what!

All of us are called to holiness, whether we serve God as religious or not. All of us are called to live out our baptism each day. And we are all called, when it comes to God, "to serve not be served." I hope these mediations have been helpful to you and your faith journey. Let's continue to on road to find God together. Every morning we must hear the words Jesus asked Peter along the seashore – he asks you and me same: "DO YOU LOVE ME?" Well, do we?

May God who is manifested in the Sacraments pour forth His abundant grace upon us! Father Justin


