

From the Pastor's Desk

My dear parish family:

Over the next five weeks of Lent, instead of a written column, I am going to be sharing with you images of Jesus' Passion and Death, that we can meditate upon these 40 days in anticipation of Easter in April. This week we begin in the Garden of Gethsemane, when Judas, one of the Twelve, betrays the Son of God. *Look at the image in all its detail - put yourself in the scene - meditate on the Lord's Passion.*



The Baroque artist **Guercino** (1591–1666) depicts the moment **Judas betrays Jesus** in the garden of Gethsemane. Judas cowers in the left foreground with a bag of silver as the soldiers lay hands on Jesus. Typically, artists of the scene depict the kiss of Judas. Guercino instead focuses on the emotional exchange between Judas and Christ, as Jesus says, "Friend, do what you are here to do" (Matt. 26:50). Judas watches, horrified, as the soldier to his left drops a rope around Christ's neck. Only Matthew's Gospel mentions Judas's later remorse (27:3–10). "I have sinned by betraying innocent blood," Judas told the religious authorities. He threw the pieces of silver in the temple, then went and hanged himself. Like Matthew, Guercino portrays Judas's painful loathing for what he has done. Guercino invites viewers not only to recognize their selfish motivations but to return to the compassionate and forgiving Christ. (*cf. commentary by Heidi J. Hornik and Mikeal C. Parsons)

May these days of Lent strengthen our faith and love for Christ!




