*From the Pastor's Desk*

My dear parish family:



Here's a story I bet you never heard! Canon law requires all bishops to come to Rome to appear before the Pope every five years. One such visit occurred between Bishop William Borders of Orlando, Florida and Pope (now Saint) Paul VI. It was just after the Apollo 11 mission when astronauts Neil Armstrong and Buzz Aldrin landed the lunar module on the moon on July 20, 1969. Paul VI was quite engaged with the mission, following it on television and peering at the Moon through the telescope at the Vatican Observatory. During his visit, Bishop Borders mentioned to the Pope that he was the "bishop of the Moon". Responding to the Pontiff's perplexed reaction he explained that according to the 1917 Code of Canon Law (in effect at that time) any newly discovered territory was placed under the jurisdiction of the diocese from which the expedition which discovered that territory left. Since Cape Canaveral, launching site for the Apollo moon missions was in Brevard County and part of the Diocese of Orlando, then in addition to being bishop of 13 counties he was also bishop of the moon! So, if we ever colonize the moon, I might be transferring to the Diocese of Orlando!

The planets and all their moons – the stars and all the cosmic heavens – the entire universe, much of it still to be discovered belongs not to a bishop in Florida or even the National Aeronautics and Space Administration; it belongs to God for He created them. And to God's Only Begotten Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ is revered as The King of the Universe – our solemn feast this weekend, marking the end of Ordinary Time and ushering us towards Advent next weekend.

Saint Justin Martyr, beautifully described how the first Christians received communion, saying that they "made their hands like a throne" to receive the Lord. The very title "Christ the King" has outlasted most of the world's monarchies. Kings, of course, have fallen out of fashion — there are only about 30 real monarchs now ruling in the world. Most of them are just figureheads. But the one we honor and celebrate today, of course, isn't. As Paul describes him today: he is the "firstborn of all creation...for in him all the fullness was pleased to dwell." This is the one we celebrate. This is the one we prepare to welcome next month at Christmas.

***"The king of glory comes, the nation rejoices, open the gates before him, lift up your voices."*** That's how the old hymn goes. Let us open the gates. Let us lift up our voices. Let us stretch out our hands.

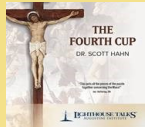

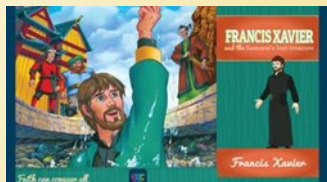

Scrip is "no-selling" fundraising. On June 1, 2010, changes were required in the Scrip Program to keep in compliance with current IRS regulations. Scrip purchasers will have multiple options of how to use Scrip rebates. You can use your rebate money as tuition credit, or as a donation to the school.
