What risk did the Canaanite woman take when she cried, "Have pity on me, Lord, Son of David!" Who are the risk takers today? For the environment? For racial justice? For caring for people with the virus? Is anything great gained without risk? The woman who was sick took a risk when she furtively touched the hem of Jesus' cloak: she risked being ridiculed. But she risked because she wanted to be cured, she wanted to reach Jesus. Remember the Canaanite woman. Do I take risks, or do I follow Jesus according to the rules of my insurance company?

Do I put my faith in Jesus?

Do I entrust my life to Jesus? Am I walking behind Jesus even if sometimes I seem ridiculous? Or am I sitting still, watching what others are doing?


