

It is every adult's moral responsibility to report known or suspected abuse or neglect of a minor to the

responsible authorities. Sexual abuse of minors is a pervasive societal

problem, and only concerted and sustained efforts by all adults in every segment of society can help to protect children and youth. In the current

Pennsylvania state report there were 5,202 substantiated reports of child abuse in Pennsylvania during 2019. 2,087 or 40% of the substantiated reports were for sexual abuse, 1, 448 were physical abuse.
