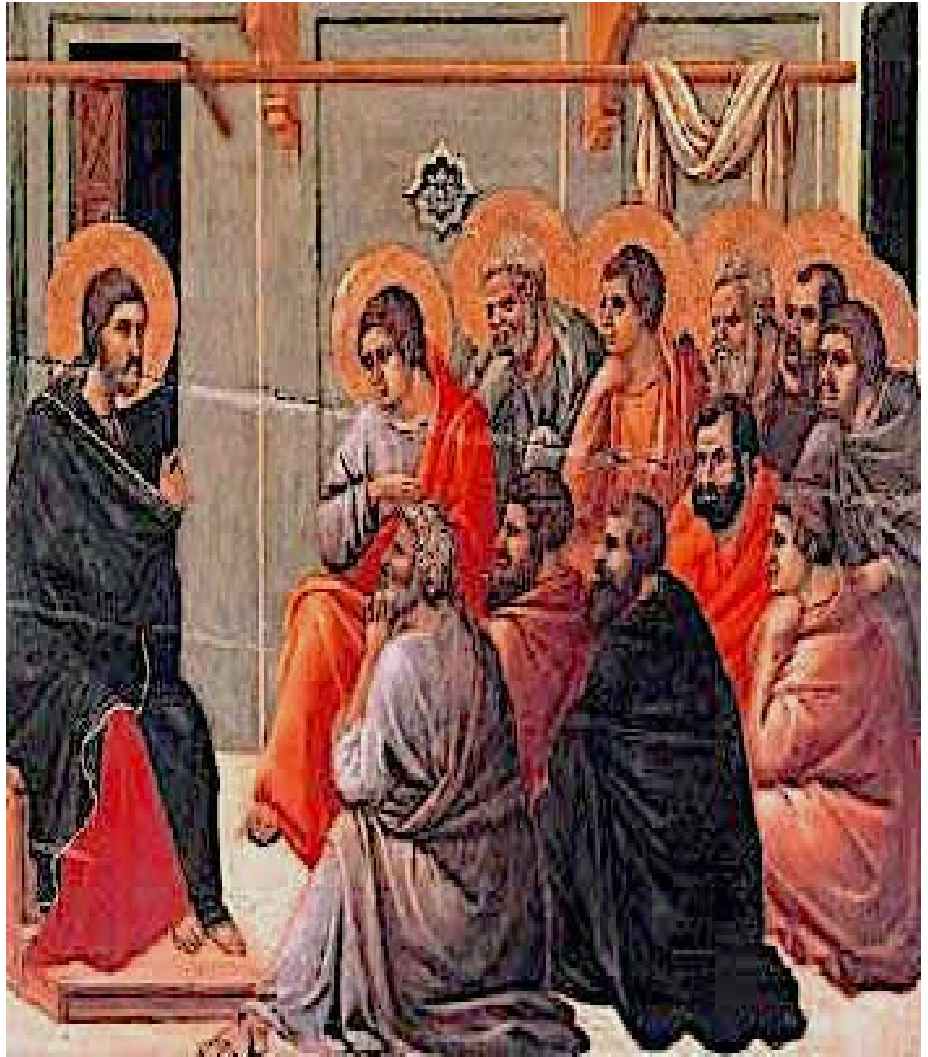

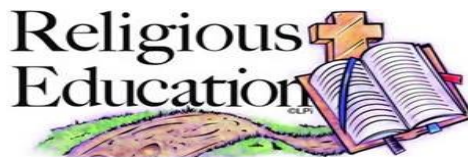
### GOOD SHEPHERD
