






22rd SUN-DAY in ORDINARY TIME

Gospel: Luke 14: 25-33

Discipleship requires both renunciation and calculation. Those who wish to follow Jesus must renounce everyone and everything that gets in the way of a single-minded response to Jesus' invitation to be his disciple. At the same time, disciples are not naively to follow Jesus. They must calculate and consent to the cost—the price is giving their all, even their own life. Labor Day is an annual celebration of the social and economic achievements of


American workers. Even though we celebrate this holiday in a special way, there will be no Mass this year on Labor Day itself.
