15th SUNDAY in ORDINARY TIME

How does one define "neighbor"? This time Jesus answers with the parable of the Good Samaritan. Three characters, a priest, a Levite, and a Samaritan,

separately come upon a robbery victim beaten up on the side of the road. The first two men (who are very much like the man who knows the law) ignore the man

and pass him by, but the outsider to Jewish law picks the man up, treats him with compassion, and cares for his needs. The parable ends with Jesus offering the

final question of debate. When the questioner is asked to identify the neighbor of the man lying in the road, we hope that perhaps he identifies his own arrogance in the priest and the Levite in the parable. He names as neighbor the one who treated the man with mercy. Perhaps the scholar of the law realizes that he has failed to be neighbor to Jesus in his desire to test him. Regardless, Jesus acts with mercy as well, as he simply sends the man away with the command: "Go and do likewise."

SUNDAY, AUG. 21, 2022 at the Rod & Gun Club.


The picnic will begin with Mass at 11:00 AM. Hot dogs, hamburgers, table service and drinks will be provided by the parish. Bring your

make the celebration complete!


