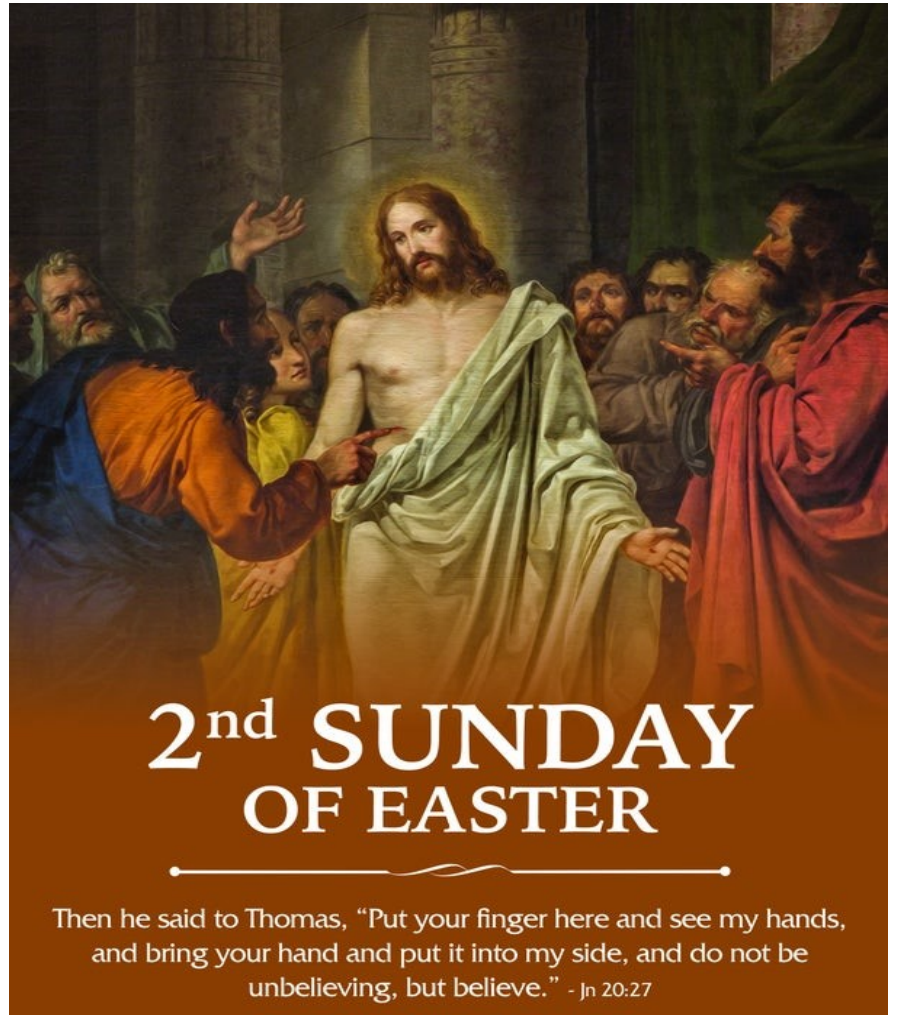

## NEW TV MONITORS FOR THE CHURCH

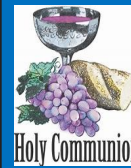

With sessions for adults as well as youth of all ages. Please join us, we’d love to see your family here with us!



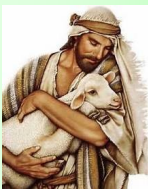
