

PALM SUNDAY

Gospel: Mark 14:1-15:47

Who reveals the identity of Iesus? Ironically, it is from enemies and foreigners that we come to understand who Jesus is. The religious leaders ask Jesus if he is "the Christ, the Son of the Blessed One." Pilate condemns him because he is the "King of the Jews." But the Roman centurion confesses this man to be "the Son of God." As we stand this day at the foot of the cross, what do we come to understand about who Jesus is?

Catholic Church regulations for fasting and abstinence for Good Friday.

- Everyone 14 years of age or older is bound to abstain from meat on Good Friday.
- Everyone 18 or older, and under 59 years of age, is bound to fast on Good Friday.
- On Good Friday, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.
- Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.
