

# FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER Gospel: John 15:1-8

**Bearing fruit—and even more** fruit—requires pruning. The pruning tool of the Father-vine grower is the Son's word. Allowing this word to shape us brings forth a life-giving relationship with Jesus (likened to a branch that remains on a vine) that assures abundant and good fruit. Five times we are told to bear fruit. Eight times we are told to remain in Jesus. How many times, then, must we be shaped by the word?

# **IUBILEE 2025 ~ YEAR OF PRAYER~**

THE YEAR OF On Jan. 21 of this year, Pope Francis launched the Year of Prayer in preparation for the jubilee and PRAYER called on Catholics "to pray more fervently to prepare ourselves to live properly this grace-filled event and to experience the power of hope in God." The Year of Prayer, the pope said, is dedicated "to rediscovering the great value and absolute need for prayer, prayer in personal life, in the life of the Church, prayer in the world." Archbishop Rino Fisichella, pre-perfect of the Dicastery for Evangelization, and who is in charge of coordinating the Year of

Prayer, said "It's a privileged time in which to rediscover the value of prayer and the need for daily prayer in our Christian life."

He added that the Year of Praver offers "a time to discover how to prav and, above all, how to educate the people of today in prayer, in this age of digital culture, so that prayer can be effective and fruitful."
