

NATIONAL HUNGER:

More than 12 million children in the United States are not getting enough food. We will be asking them to do things like expanding free school meals through the Community Eligibility Provision Program and extend it through the summer nationwide. You have an opportunity to write to Congress representatives about WORLD HUNGER, as well. There are 811 million people worldwide that lack sufficient food. We will be asking Congress to cosponsor Global Malnutrition Prevention and Treatment Act, and to increase global nutrition funding. These issues will escalate as the war in Ukraine continues. Grain prices will rise as much as 50% in some countries because Russia and Ukraine account for more that 25% of the world's exported wheat.
