

# DECREE

Revising the practice of the faithful during the

**Communion Rite of the Mass** 

THEREFORE, in accord with paragraph 42 of the General Instruction of the Roman Missal, I direct that the faithful in the Diocese of Erie shall kneel at Mass following the conclusion of the Agnus Dei.

Those who receive Holy Communion may, upon returning to their place, either kneel or sit according to their choice until the beginning of the praver after communion, at which time all stand.

I direct this Decree be published and take effect on the First Sunday of Advent, which begins at 4:00 p.m. on Nov. 27, 2021, anything to the contrary notwithstanding.
